



Phare de Kéréon (Brittany, France)

Solitary watchtower in the Passage du Fromveur - between Ouessant and Molène on the rock Men Tensel. Facts: - Construction period: 1907-1916 - Height: 47.25 m - Range: up to 17 sm. (comparable to approximately 15 stories) - ...

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Points of interest: - Nickname "Le Palace": because of its unusually elegant interior with mosaics in the stairwell, wood paneling from Hungarian oak and parquet with inlaid compass rose. - The Fromveur is one of the strongest current passages in Brittany (partly ~9 kn) - hence the spectacular waves at the tower.

Coordinates: 48°26'14" N, 5°01'32" W
