



Our Invisible Legacy

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Many environmental burdens from the chemical industry, metal processing, and intensive agriculture from the 1950s-80s are still seeping into our groundwater today.

For example solvents, heavy metals (e.g. mercury, lead) Pesticides such as DDT - once a widely used insecticide, today banned - extremely persistent & hormone-disrupting. Atrazin: popular herbicide, banned in the EU - highly water-soluble, still contaminating many groundwater reserves. Nitrate surplus due to decades of over-fertilization.

Why is this dangerous?

Bacteria are filtered out well. But with many chemicals, microplastics, or heavy metals, only a limit value applies - not zero! In the long term, they can promote cancer, hormonal disorders, or nerve damage.
